Managed general access computing labs, teaching labs, and the residence hall network, which supported university students, faculty, staff, and occasionally community entities. Labs provided computers (PCs/Apples) with over two hundred programs to offer a diverse spectrum of applications and services for the different disciplines needed in an academic environment. Duties included technical aspects of design, configuration, installation and development of facilities and servers; developed techniques of implanting applications on a network unprecedented in the field to facilitate needs within a strict budget.

Administrative duties focused on all aspects of managing the 45 to 60 mostly part time student staff: recruitment, hiring, training, coaching, counseling, disciplining and terminating. Duties also included design and development of facilities, serving on campus committees to determine technical direction, assisting other facilities on campus, responsibility for multiple budgets, maintaining software legalities, evaluating hardware and software for purchase, writing proposals, writing reports, developing staff and facility policies.
